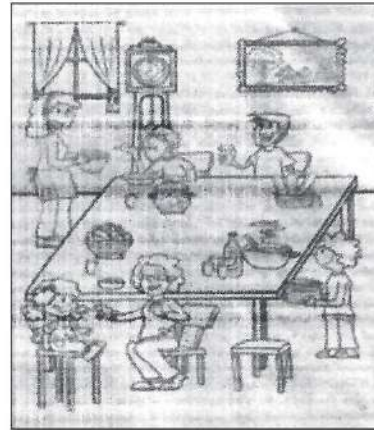

- The principle behind any firework is that when heat is applied to fuel (the gun powder), it burns using oxygen. 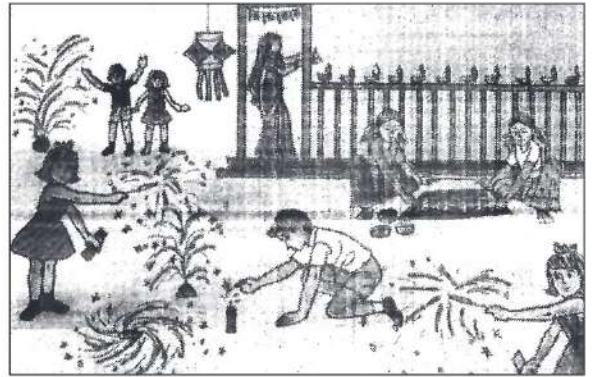
